#### J. GEILS BAND — Centerfold

Lead singer Peter Wolf was married to Faye Dunaway.

#### KAJAGOOGOO - Too Shy

Kajagoogoo started a trend in England known as Googoomania.

#### RICK SPRINGFIELD — Jessie's Girl

On the day of MTV's debut, "Jessie's Girl" was the number one song in the country. Rick Springfield played Dr. Noah Drake on General Hospital. His real name is Richard Lewis Springthorp.

#### NENA - 99 Luftballons

The band's name comes from its lead vocalist Gabriele Susanna "Nena" Kerner.

#### BELINDA CARLISLE — Heaven Is A Place On Earth

An active member of the early punk scene in Los Angeles, this former cheer-leader worked nights as a gas station attendant to save money for her big move to Los Angeles to pursue her musical career.

#### DONNA SUMMER — She Works Hard For The Money

Disco's greatest diva appeared in the German production of *Hair* and European production of *Godspell* before embarking on her solo career.

#### JOHN WAITE - Missing You

John Waite was the lead singer of the Babys. He sang "Missing You" on the TV series "Paper Dolls."

## TRIVIAL

#### RAY PARKER JR. — Ghostbusters

After 60 other songs were rejected. Ray Parker Jr.'s song was chosen for the film *Ghostbusters*, one of the highest grossing movies of the decade. Parker commented. "It's hard to write a song where your main objective is to use the word Ghostbuster. There aren't many words that rhyme with it."

#### SHEENA EASTON — Morning Train

Sheena Easton won a Grammy in 1984 for best Mexican/American performance for "Me Gustas Tal Como Eres." The BBC filmed a program about her quest for stardom while she was still an unknown.

#### **CULTURE CLUB** — Karma Chameleon

Culture Club was the first act since the Beatles to have three top ten singles on their debut album. Boy George's real name is George Alan O'Dowd.
